## Comparative Risks of Serious Health Problems

estimated per 100,000 women per year

### Does not use hormonal birth control

**Heart Attack**  
Fewer than 18  
out of 100,000  
(17.02)



**Stroke**  
Fewer than 18  
out of 100,000  
(17.1)



**Blood Clots**  
Fewer than 6  
out of 100,000  
(5.9)



### Uses hormonal birth control

**Heart Attack**  
Fewer than 26  
out of 100,000  
(25.5)



**Stroke**  
28 out of 100,000  
(28)



**Blood Clots**  
Fewer than 18  
out of 100,000  
(17.8)



# Age group – 40s smokers

## Comparative Risks of Death

estimated per 100,000 women per year

### Does not use hormonal birth control

**Heart Attack**  
Fewer than 6  
out of 100,000  
(5.1)



**Stroke**  
5 out of 100,000  
(5)



**Blood Clots**  
Fewer than 1  
out of 100,000  
(0.12)



### Uses hormonal birth control

**Heart Attack**  
Fewer than 8  
out of 100,000  
(7.7)



**Stroke**  
Fewer than 9  
out of 100,000  
(8.1)



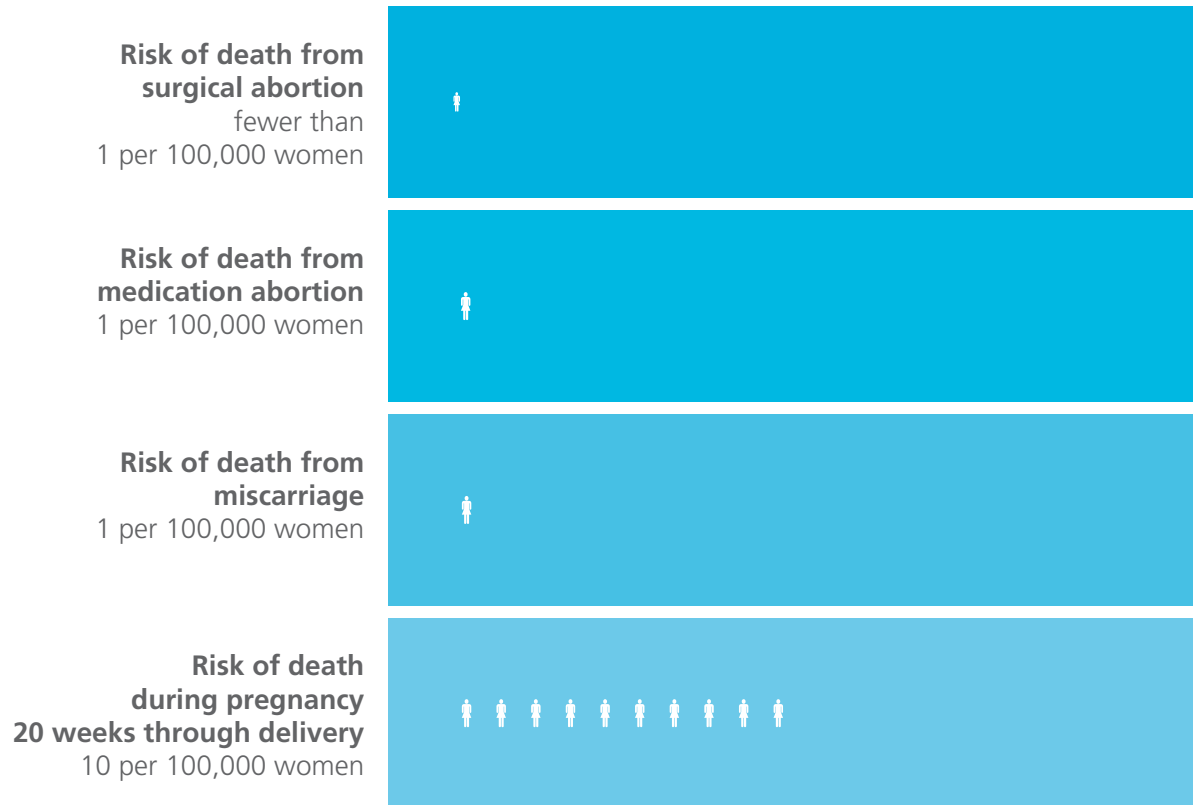
**Blood Clots**
